Civic Center Update – New Milestones

Project Updates:

The Civic Center will feature public facilities that address several community needs including a Community Center, Senior Center, Council Chambers/Performing Arts Venue, and City Hall. It will be on a 12-acre site in the vicinity of Commercentre Drive and Civic Center Drive, alongside the future Serrano Summit housing development. The Civic Center is expected to open in mid-2019. Housing development continues to progress throughout Lake Forest. Portola Center, located at the intersection of Saddleback Ranch Road and Glenn Ranch Road, will include 930 homes including 613 singlefamily and 317 multi-family homes. The 195-acre site will feature 10,000 square feet of commercial space, a 5-acre public park fitted with playgrounds, picnic areas, and sports fields, new trails with exercise stations, three private neighborhood parks, and 44-plus acres of open space including a perimeter trail available to the public. Model homes are now open in the north, west, and south areas of the planned community.

The Serrano Summit development is a subdivision of approximately 82 acres and includes future Civic Center Site and trail connections. In total, 608 homes will be constructed. The new development is located on Commercentre and Civic Center Drive, directly across from the future Civic Center. Grading is currently underway.
